GINGERBREAD HOUSE COMPETITION RULES

SIZE LIMITATIONS, IDENTIFICATION, AND DESCRIPTION:

- The entry with a base must not exceed 25 inches high, 15 inches wide and 15 inches long.
- Entry must be placed on a board base. Board can be either ½” or ¾” plywood.
- Write your name, address, and entry number on the underside of your base.
- Suffolk Lodge #60 F. & A. M. reserves the right to refuse any entry at our discretion.

MATERIALS AND CONSTRUCTION

Except for the base, entries must be constructed and composed completely of edible materials. No perishable items, dried seeds or nuts are allowed. The main structure should be constructed primarily of gingerbread. Paint and or ribbon may be used to decorate the outer edge of your plywood base (not to exceed the length and/or width of the base). Any entry with non-edible components will automatically be disqualified. Edible materials are not limited to sweets. No artificial materials, such as Styrofoam or interior lighting, are to be used in the construction or decoration of the entry. Candies must be unwrapped and free of any non-edible materials such as lollipop sticks. The individual(s) entering the competition must solely construct all entries. Competitors under the age of 18 may be supervised, for safety precautions, by a parent, legal guardian, or classroom teacher. However, all design, construction, and decoration shall be done; solely by the individual(s) entering the competition. (Acceptable Supervision Example: When competitors under age of 18 require assistance with operating the oven and/or stovetop.)

ENTRY FEE (NON-REFUNDABLE)

\$25.00 per Gingerbread House, payable by check or PayPal, Checks shall be made payable Suffolk 60

ENTRY FORM DEADLINE:

Entry forms can be filed online or mailed/dropped off at: Suffolk Lodge #60 F. & A. M. 312 Main Street, Port Jefferson, NY 11777. To be eligible for the competition, either a signed and completed entry form with entry fee must be received by mail or electronically by Tuesday, December 3rd, 2019. All online entries must accept the terms, conditions and rules when submitting the form in lieu of a physical signature. Entries that are not pre-registered will not be accepted. Entry numbers will be assigned upon receipt of a completed entry form, and competitors will receive a phone call or e-mail with their entry number for the competition.

ENTRY CHECK IN:

Entries will be accepted Tuesday, December, 3rd, 2019 between the hours of 5:30pm – 9:00pm at Suffolk Lodge #60 F. & A. M. 312 Main Street Port Jefferson, NY 11777.

JUDGING:

1. Judges will award points for the following criteria: Overall Appearance, Originality & Creativity, Difficulty, Precision, and Consistency of Theme (Theme should be competitors own and consistent throughout the entry). There is no required theme for the competition.
2. All rulings by the judges are independent and final Points will be deducted for any deviation to the rules.
3. Judging is scheduled to take place on Thursday, December 5th, 2019.
4. During the Dickens Festival the public will be able view houses and vote for their favorite house.

DISPLAY INFORMATION:

1. Entries will be on display at the Masonic Lodge Saturday, December 7st thru Sunday, December 8th, 2019.
2. All competitors agree to let Suffolk 60 F. & A. M. use pictures of their entries for publicity purposes.

ENTRY PICK-UP:

Houses must be picked up Wednesday, December 11th, 2019 between the hours of 5:30 pm and 8:00 pm. Entries not picked up will be discarded beginning the afternoon of Thursday, December 12th, 2019. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
